Letter from the Benefice Ministry Team

A hot afternoon in July 1785 saw the beginning of a paradigm shift in the world of engineering. Honoré Blanc, a gunsmith, demonstrated how he could take apart flintlock rifles, mix the parts up and then reassemble the guns and, to everyone's surprise, make them work. Blanc had hit upon the idea of interchangeability of parts, and it would revolutionise existing industry and form the basis on which many new products and industries would go on to be built, including, amongst other things, the motorcar.

The idea was simple, but revolutionary. What if, instead of each product (in Honoré's case, the gun) being bespoke and unique, a particular product could be developed so that every version of it used identical and easily interchangeable parts? Production costs would decrease, repairs would become cheaper and quicker, and the life of the product could be extended. Needless to say, Blanc's fellow gun-makers were un-impressed by this threat to their livelihoods...Nowadays interchangeability is a central part of the world economy, so in that sense I guess Honoré won the day.

But what does this have to do with Christmas? I want to suggest that in some senses interchangeability is at work in the Christmas story. If we follow the Christian narrative that each person is created unique by God, but shares in an essential and corporate humanity, which bears the image and imprint of God, we follow a story in which the particular and the universal co-exist quite happily. Each person uniquely created, but sharing a universal humanity. If we continue with the Christian story, then we begin to see that the particular and the universal are manifest in other ways too. For example, the scriptures speak about the condition of humankind in suffering the brokenness and corruption of sin as being universal but also particular. Sin experienced as a species but also as an individual, and in both cases with the terrible consequence of alienation from God, one another and the creation.

Into this dilemma, both universal and particular, enters the creator at a crucial time in his plan of salvation and redemption. Into this dilemma steps God in Christ. Born in a first century Palestinian home, God made particular, whilst being no less universal.

But where is the interchangeability? Well, I think the interchangeability is found in so far as God, made particular in Christ, steps into our world to provide a solution to its greatest and most pressing problem, the problem of sin and alienation. Jesus Christ, whose birth we celebrate at Christmas, like a part in Honoré's flintlock, universally fits in to any particular life with the offer of salvation. Like the springs, flints and hammers that Blanc developed, there is no life or situation into which Christ cannot fit and bring his redemption and healing and freedom from sin. The universal, made particular, to solve the universal and particular problem of sin... perfectly interchangeable, fitting in to any and every life and heart and mind that will receive him as a demonstration of God's perfect love.

It's always a challenge to find a new way of writing the Christmas editorial, but I hope the above provides some food for thought! All that's left is for me to wish you a very Happy Christmas from the whole of the ministry team in the North Hampshire Downs Network of Churches. We hope very much to see you at one or more of our Christmas services and events and do please take the time to read our new rota of services which takes effect from January 1st.

A Season of Change in Our Churches

There are significant changes in the clergy team over the coming 12 months. During this time, we will need to adapt our patterns and structures to cope with reduced clergy numbers and to ensure that we are still able to maintain vibrant churches. The changes to the clergy team are as follows:

- Rev Mary-Beth Hawrish (Vicar of Long Sutton and South Warnborough) will retire from ministry in January 2020. This post will not be filled.
- Rev Alison Brown (Vicar of Odiham) will retire from Ministry in January 2020. We will recruit to fill this post and hope to have someone in place towards the end of 2020.
- Rev Helen O'Sullivan (Curate with primary focus in the United Parish) will complete her curacy in the July 2020 and is likely to move to take up her first incumbent level post not long after.

With these changes, we are not able to sustain the current volume and pattern of Sunday services.

• Clergy rarely have enough time between multiple services to engage with worshippers before or after a service. This is unsatisfactory and makes pastoral conversations and welcoming newcomers difficult.

- Clergy often arrive at a service with only a few minutes to spare before the service is due to start. This means sufficient time is not available to prepare and set up resources.
- Clergy quickly become 'communion dispensers', often having to miss a large and well attended non-Eucharistic service to preside at a far smaller and less well attended communion service.

From January 2020, the service patterns for the whole Benefice will change. In making the changes we have ensured that:

- We maintain a fair balance between traditional Book of Common Prayer services (both communion and Evensong), Common Worship Holy Communion services and informal non-liturgical services.
- The schedule allows time for clergy to move from one service to another without having to leave a service early or arrive at a service late.
- Clergy are not asked to lead and preach at more than 3 services each Sunday. Given that half of our clergy team give their time on a voluntary 'self-supporting basis', this is important.

With such a change comes opportunities for pioneering new things which lead to growth. There also comes a degree of loss. Over the course of a month, each and every church in the Benefice will need to give up something in order for the whole to function and grow. It will take us a little time to adapt to the new pattern. We might find that on occasion we need to travel outside of the parish in which we live to attend our preferred style of service. The good news is that our churches are all very close together and just as we travel to see friends, go shopping and enjoy leisure activities on a daily basis, so the occasional visit to another parish should not be unduly difficult. After 12 months the service pattern will be reviewed in consultation with Churchwardens and if necessary further changes will be made.

To Conclude:

The changes that we will undertake are vital for the long-term flourishing of our churches, and indeed vital to ensuring that we retain a worshipping Christian community in each of our 12 villages. The changes will allow us to honour and serve our current congregations and re-engage the missing generation - that is those between the ages of 30 and 45 - and love and serve our wider communities. In this month's edition of the parish magazine you will find a table (follows) which details the new pattern of services across our network of churches. Sincerely yours, **Rev. NEWS FROM THE VILLAGES

Dear residents

I begin this month with an appeal for any information in relation to the several windows being shot at by ball bearings. I am aware that this type of incident has been on going in Upton Grey on November 1st and 2nd, and again on November 6th and 7th. We have established that it was predominately ball bearings being fired from a vehicle as it drove along the Bidden and Weston Roads along with Church Street. The first incidents were in the region of between 10pm and 2am, whilst the second set was in the region of 9.30pm. This type of incident also happened in North Warnborough, Odiham, Crondall, Tunworth, Cliddesden, Tadley and several area's across Berkshire, so it is not that we are being targeted it is simply mindless people firing projectiles from a car and we suspect using a catapult. If anyone has any CCTV or can assist, please give me a call direct.

Also, on November 1st, we had a burglary to an outbuilding in Tunworth Down where the thieves made off in a dark 4x4 vehicle this at about 10 pm. A further similar crime has also been reported in the same area on November 14th 2019, when several articles of garden equipment have been stolen, we suspect this crime took place at about 3 am. Another similar burglary occurred at a business premises in Scratchface Lane, Herriard, this crime took place between 5pm and 5 am on November 1st and 2nd 2019. Overnight of October 17th and 18th at a house in Back Lane Herriard some building related items were stolen, again if you saw anything unusual that day in Back Lane please give me a call direct. As Christmas approaches may I please remind residents to leave lights and radios etc. on when not at home, consider using sensor lighting and alarms to protect your home and property.

May I take this opportunity to wish you all a very happy and crime free Christmas and New Year, also special wishes to my Neighbourhood Watch co-ordinators of whom I encourage all residents to please sign up with, they do a fantastic job, please contact your local co-coordinator, all we need is simply an email address and you will receive updates on local crime, things to be aware of etc.

Herriard Gardening Club

Our November meeting was a chance to make plans for the winter months with our Christmas Get Together in December at the British Legion and a New Year pub dinner. We also planned who will host next year's monthly meetings. It is always a pleasure to look around, often enviously, at other's gardens. I particularly like to see planting companions in borders that work well and to pick up new ideas. While we all share similar soil type and weather conditions it is surprising how gardens in the same village can have varied pests to contend with and how some plants will do well in one garden but perform poorly in another. Gardening is full of surprises. Needless to say, there is always some sharing of seeds or plants among us, as well as problem solving suggestions. As we approach the shortest day of the year, make the most of daylight hours outdoors.

Gardening jobs for December:

- 1. Insulate outdoor taps and check winter protection
- 2. Prune open grown apples and pears (but not those grown against walls)
- 3. Prune acers, birches and vines before Christmas to avoid bleeding

- 5. Do some fireside garden planning

Delia's Christmas Chutney

Here is Delia's recipe for Christmas Chutney, delicious served with cold meats, pate or cheese. It is made with Christmassy dried fruits.

- 350g no soak prunes
- 275g pitted dates
- 275g no soak dried apricots
- 450g onions
- 570ml cider vinegar
- 50g salt

- 1 dessertspoon grated fresh ginger or 1 heaped teaspoon dried ginger
- 75g allspice berries
- 450g demerara sugar
- A small piece of muslin
- 1. Chop the dried fruits and onions very small (by hand or in a food processor)
- 2. Place vinegar in a large saucepan with the salt and ginger. Tie the allspice berries up in the muslin secured tightly and add to the pan.
- 3. Bring to the boil, then stir in the chopped fruit and onions together with the sugar
- 4. Simmer for about 1hour 30mins gently with lid off or until chutney has thickened. Stir from time to time to prevent sticking.
- 5. It is ready when you draw a spoon across the surface, and it makes a trail
- 6. Spoon chutney into warm, sterilised jars, seal with a wax disc and tight lid. Label. This chutney will keep well for months in a cool dark place. Have a very happy Christmas! Gill Hill
