

**Letter from the Benefice Ministry Team**

‘In the autumn of 1932, at the age of three-and-a-half, I went shopping with my mother in Hull, and as we walked home we passed the entrance to East Park. Just inside the entrance was a playground, and I begged to be allowed a turn on the swings. My mother said I could, but soon said we must go home as it was dinner time. I pleaded for one more go, and she unwisely allowed me, and left me on the promise that I would soon follow. After one more swing I dutifully stopped, but, leaving the park, for some unfathomable reason instead of turning left for home I turned right into Holderness Road, leading to the city centre. I walked and walked until I was hopelessly lost. Eventually, almost in the bustling middle of Hull, I was rescued by a kind passer-by and, as I fortunately knew my home address, was led home, a very tired, frightened and forlorn little boy. It could have been the most dangerous incident in my little life. The possible consequences of taking a wrong turning are enormous. Yet day by day we are faced with choices; we have to decide between one course of action and another; and we have to live with the consequences. How can we guard against unwise choices?’

There are many places in the Bible where life-changing choices had to be made. For example, when the Israelites eventually entered the Promised Land Joshua called upon them to make a decision: ‘Choose this day whom you will serve’- the pagan gods worshipped by the locals, or the Lord God who had brought them and their ancestors safely out of Egypt. And the people wisely chose God (Joshua, chapter 24). It is, of course, God who chooses us (John 15: 16), but it is our choice how we respond. When Jesus came, people were invited to make choices about him. Many believed in him, but many did not (see for example John 12: 36 – 43). And so, it is today, though I am sure that many who do not believe don't really know enough to make a considered choice. They would be wise to keep an open mind until they know more, and see what is on offer, and how it has transformed other people's lives.

Taking a wrong turning can be very costly, and you can't be certain that some kind person will turn up and put you right. I was lucky’.

## FROM THE VILLAGES

### Local Police Report

‘Dear Residents, I start this month’s article with an appeal for any information concerning several crimes towards the end of December and early January. Between December 1st and 18<sup>th</sup>, a shed was broken into at a house in Cleaves Lane, Upton Grey; damage was inflicted on crops near Lee Farm, Herriard overnight of December 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; a padlock broken to a wood on the Village Road at Tunworth; and this year we had further crop damage caused by poachers at Manor Farm, Upton Grey during the afternoon of Wednesday January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018. A chainsaw was also stolen from a garage in Cemetery Lane, Upton Grey between January 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. I ask if anyone has any information concerning any of these crimes please give me a call direct.

In last month’s edition I wrote of the reported crime figures for the areas of this magazine which I reproduce below. Generally, across the twenty-two parishes of this former beat area (changed in 2014 as part of a force-wide re-organisation), crime rose as it has yearly since 2014 with 211 crimes reported during the year, an increase of 37 on the 2016 figure of 174. Some are as a result in the change to Home Office crime recording standards.

The breakdown of various crimes across the beat area saw an increase in burglary of homes with ten being reported across the whole 72 square mile area and criminal damage offences which was predominately damage to crops by poachers. Thankfully we saw a reduction in non-dwelling burglaries i.e. sheds and outbuildings. However, we need to remain alert and sadly those that have had items stolen in the past may have a future visit as we are aware of thieves returning to steal replacement items and machinery, however good security, alarms possibly CCTV etc will all help to reduce you becoming a victim of crime. ### **Good News with Upton Grey Shop Post Office Re-Opening!**

The Upton Grey Post Office, at Upton Grey Village Shop, re-opens **Tuesday 6th February at 1.30pm**. The Post Office will then be open every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon from 1.30-3.30pm, offering the same services as before along with car tax and on demand travel insurance. Here is an extract from the Post Office management.

'...The branch closed temporarily in March 2017 due to the resignation of the Postmaster. We are pleased to be able to reinstate the service as a temporary measure while we continue to seek a permanent solution. The new service will be operated from the same address as previously and will offer a range of Post Office products and services as before. ### **February Gardening Tips**

1. Sow tomato and melon seeds in the greenhouse
2. Prune shrubs and shrub roses - for most you can reduce by one-third
3. Add soil-improver (e.g. Pro-grow) and fleece to accelerate warming of the soil
4. Spread compost or chicken manure pellets on the soil. No need to dig it in.

## **Herriard Parish Council – Highlights from Meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> Dec 2017**

Present: Cllr. Gemma Hounsell, Cllr. Gareth Davies (Chairman), David Freer (Clerk). In attendance: PC Andy Reid, Ian Lansley-Neale (comms), Patricia Pegg, Rod Bolt, HCC Cllr. Anna McNair Scott, Rebecca Wills.

1. **Latest Police Report.** Key points raised and discussed included: Recent high-tech thefts using Bluetooth to find computer equipment left in people's cars; Dog nuisance on Herriard Green and PC Andy Reid's note that there is a borough dog warden who could advise us on preventative measures; PC Andy Reid will liaise with the Herriard Parish Council (HPC) and Rebecca Wills to organise a village meeting/discussion about security and local police/neighbourhood watch issues in the new year. Cllr Anna McNair Scott raised the issue of rural police funding discussions and her reticence for wealthy villages to pay for extra police support - but also her acknowledgement that the situation with PC Andy Reid's pressures should be eased.
2. **Dog nuisance on Herriard Green.** Patricia Pegg raised issue of her friend who was attacked by a dog on the Green on three separate occasions. It was agreed that serious issues should be reported directly to the police. HPC also proposed that preventative measures should be discussed with the borough dog warden, and raised in the police/neighbourhood watch meeting planned by PC Andy Reid and Rebecca Wills in the new year. Action: Cllr Davies
3. **Roads and Traffic.** Areas discussed included: A339, Avenue Speed restriction; & Golden Pot junction. HPC's desire to extend the 40mph limit on A339 south to beyond the junction with The Avenue. Ian Lansley-Neale raised issue of traffic on The Avenue and updated on his recent TARA meeting with Mark Kemp-Gee and Ian Janes. Ian confirmed in the meeting that implementing speed limits is now very difficult. The three areas that are most dangerous are: (a) The Avenue junction with the A339 (b) the Golden Pot junction and (c) high speeds along The Avenue. The three most obvious measures to help with traffic safety on The Avenue include: (a) speed limit (40mph); (b) road narrowing (c) visual narrowing (outside white lines). TARA are going to press for action initially on option (c) as the first two are too difficult by HCC. Cllr Anna McNair Scott was introduced to Rod Bolt, and it was suggested that the two of them should liaise on the best people to speak to in HCC to improve the problems on the roads around Herriard (since the meeting, they have been introduced via email). Action: Rod Bolt. Feedback from local villagers on recent

speed restrictions on the A339 have been very positive. Our next step should be to extend it.

4. **Herriard Housing Project.** Updates from Cllrs Jervoise/Davies: Planning permission has been submitted. As below.

Cllr Gareth Davies highlighted that the whole plan is the result of the village scheme started by the Parish Council, we will ask for Herriard village to voice support.

Positives to highlight in any feedback include: the fact that it will provide housing the local village says it needs; that it will provide income for the parish council (replacing loss of Council funding) and will be self-funded. Cllr Gareth Davies highlighted that Herriard's plans are being closely watched by many other rural villages as a positive and innovative approach to future housing needs. Action: Cllr Davies/Clerk. Additional note from HPC as at 19/1/18 'The official consultation deadline has now passed, but if any of you missed it, comments by letter or email will still be registered.

5. **Rural transport update** - Ian Lansley-Neale reported that Hampshire have provided a taxi share service (started Nov 1st). This has been published on Facebook & the Parish Magazine. The next step will be to record how many people are using it. Action: Ian Lansley-Neale
6. **Rural Broadband** – Cllr Gareth Davies highlighted that the fringes of the village are still problem areas for fast broadband coverage. The main Herriard street cabinet was updated 2017, but it doesn't cover all areas of the village. Basingstoke & Dean have a match funding scheme for that we are investigating. Possible technologies include long range wi-fi (this won't work through wooded areas). Cllr Anna McNair Scott mentioned extensions to the HCC rural broadband project. B&DBC are coordinating their actions with this. Action: Cllr Davies
7. **Planning:**
  - (a) AD/BA103 from **Veolia**. Concerns had been conveyed to HCC and B&DBC regarding the further increase in traffic movements associated with this application. In open forum, Patricia Pegg raised her concerns about the Veolia planning application and the volume of extra traffic she felt it add to the A339 and Bushywarren lane.
  - (b) 17/03487/FUL - **Moto Motorway Service Area (MSA) at Junction 6 M3** - objection lodged. Cllr Anna McNair Scott stated that in her opinion the main issues are the extra traffic at M3 Junction 6 and the Black Dam roundabout but also that the Service area is not needed since Fleet & Winchester Services are so close.
  - (c) Patricia Pegg requested that important planning applications be shared with the village. It was suggested by David Freer that this could be part of the content for HPC's new website, and possibly a summary poster placed in village notice boards.

8. **HPC planned Herriard Village Website update** – David Freer. A new website proposal has been received by local web design company Web Directions. This proposal will improve the service for both local villagers (with more refreshed content streams, and the ability to add contact details to the directory) and will be easier for HPC to update. It was also raised that there are grants available for small parish councils to fund work like this. Cllr Gareth Davies mentioned that a similar funding channel was accessed for the previous website and proposes to check and contact the council for further information on a new grant. Action: Cllr Davies/Clerk
9. **By-Election Recharge Proposals** – Cllr Gareth Davies has discussed with Basingstoke & Deane the suggestion that Parish Councils pay for all by-elections themselves. It was initially thought that we would have to fund any by-election, but now it is thought that this will be only extraordinary by-elections.
10. **Misuse of ‘Back Lane’ Name.** Cllr. Nick White looking at extension of Back Lane name. The misuse of Back Lane past The Barracks and as far as Park Corner has been confirmed as a Google Map problem (rather than an official change). The problem has been reported to Google maps. Action: Cllr White
11. **BT Phone Boxes in Herriard.** Cllr White is managing the future use of the ex- BT kiosk outside the Fur & Feathers. Cllr. Bob Ives has plans to store the Bagmore Lane box to use for spares. Actions Cllrs Ives/White
12. **Next Meeting: Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January, 730-915; RBLH**

## **Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD) - Odiham & Old Basing Health Centre Patient Participation Group.**

Seasonal affective disorder (SAD) is a type of depression that comes and goes in a seasonal pattern. It is sometimes known as 'winter depression' because the symptoms are more apparent and tend to be more severe during the winter. The symptoms often begin in the autumn as the days start getting shorter. They're typically most severe during December, January and February. SAD often improves and disappears in the spring and summer, although it may return each autumn and winter in a repetitive pattern. Symptoms of SAD can include:

- a persistent low mood
- a loss of pleasure or interest in normal everyday activities
- irritability
- feelings of despair, guilt and worthlessness
- feeling lethargic (lacking in energy) and sleepy during the day
- sleeping for longer than normal and finding it hard to get up in the morning
- craving carbohydrates and gaining weight.

For some people, these symptoms can be severe and have a significant impact on their day-to-day activities.

**When to see your GP?** You should consider seeing your GP if you think you might have SAD and you're struggling to cope. Your GP can carry out an assessment to check your mental health. They may ask you about your mood, lifestyle, eating habits and sleeping patterns, plus any seasonal changes in your thoughts and behaviour.

**What causes SAD?** The exact cause of SAD isn't fully understood, but it's often linked to reduced exposure to sunlight during the shorter autumn and winter days.

The main theory is that a lack of sunlight might stop a part of the brain called the hypothalamus working properly, which may affect the:

- **production of melatonin** – melatonin is a hormone that makes you feel sleepy; in people with SAD, the body may produce it in higher than normal levels
- **production of serotonin** – serotonin is a hormone that affects your mood, appetite and sleep; a lack of sunlight may lead to lower serotonin levels, which is linked to feelings of depression
- **body's internal clock (circadian rhythm)** – your body uses sunlight to time various important functions, such as when you wake up, so lower light levels during the winter may disrupt your body clock and lead to symptoms of SAD

It's also possible that some people are more vulnerable to SAD because of their genes, as some cases appear to run in families.

**Treatments for SAD.** A range of treatments are available for SAD. Your GP will recommend the most suitable treatment programme for you. The main treatments are:

- **lifestyle measures** – including getting as much natural sunlight as possible, exercising regularly and managing your stress levels
- **light therapy** – where a special lamp called a light box is used to simulate exposure to sunlight
- **talking therapies** – such as **cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT)** or counselling
- **antidepressant medication** – such as selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (SSRIs)
- **Changes in diet** – the Mediterranean diet has been shown to improve mood


