# **Letter from the Benefice Ministry Team**

I always find October a bit of a strange month. It's that point in the year that seems a bit odd. We've had our summer months by then (allegedly... not that we've seen much evidence of summer this year). Children have all started new schools, or new year groups, and we're into the daily routines. looms. But we're not there yet. The month as a whole feels dark and a little uneventful. And so it's a strange time to talk about change, and newness.



# **Farming News**

Harvest was completed on the 21st August this year, which we were very relieved about as it has been one of the more testing harvests, largely due to the weather. It was a harvest spent looking at the various weather apps that I have on my phone hoping for a prolonged dry weather window that never seemed to materialise. So there were several late nights harvesting, trying to make the most of any dry weather period. The crops were surprisingly good considering that they had endured one of our wettest winters. We started harvest with our oil-seed rape back in July, followed by the wheat and finishing on our springsown barley. The oil-seed rape had a good oil content and this will be used largely for cooking oil. Our closest pressing plant is at Erith, just off the River Thames, which is where our oil-seed rape goes. The wheat varieties we grew this year were destined for low-grade milling, and will end up in plain and self-raising flour as opposed to bread making. These all achieved the quality needed for that as well. The only let down was the blended wheat that I trialled this year. I chose four 'group 1' breadmaking varieties to blend together. The reasoning for this trial was that each variety holds different traits, so the thinking was that they would complement each other, and on the whole they did, but it wasn't quite enough to make the desired quality for bread-making so will now be low grade milling. The barley all made malting quality so will eventually end up at a maltster to be used in beer, whiskey and vinegar. The by-products left from all of these processes are used predominately for animal feed so there is virtually zero waste. The straw at harvest is either swathed and baled to be used for animal feed or bedding, then once turned into manure will be spread onto the fields as fertiliser. Or it is chopped by the combine harvester and will be incorporated into the soil, so nothing is wasted. We have also planted all of our oil-seed rape for harvest 2025 already. The earlier planted crop is growing away strongly and out of reach from any pests. The later drilled crops are just emerging and the rain that is currently falling as I write this will help it to grow away quickly.

I was sat in the tractor watching the swallows circling and swooping down as they foraged on low flying bugs and midges which was amazing to see, and I think as farmers we take for granted the

wildlife we see on a day to day basis. I also think this is why it is hard to understand accusations of a diminishing environment and the blame for this being laid on farming. All of our neighbouring farmers and beyond are farming in a manner that aids the biodiversity either in the soil or around the farm — establishing wild flower meadows for pollinators, planting over-winter bird mixes which will provide food for a variety of different birds during the winter months and using cover crop mixes, which is a variety of different plants to capture all different types of nutrients in the soil and prevent them from leeching into water courses. It is extremely satisfying and rewarding to be able to do this whilst producing food.

Anyway I'll get down from my soap box and get back to farming, we will hope to be harvesting our maize at the end of September / early October and that will complete our harvest for this year. We will also be planning to start planting our autumn cereals of rye and wheat at a similar time so the next busy period is imminent. Ready to start the fun all over again.

# Do you gamble too much, or too often?



Fresh Start is a nine-week course that has been run by Harvest Church in Alton since 2019. It's to help anyone with a life-controlling habit such as smoking, gambling, drinking, over-eating, internet addiction, shopping compulsions, drugs, etc. – in fact any habit which once might have brought you comfort or fun, but is now spoiling your daily living.

Fresh Start is based on principles from the 12-steps-of-recovery process, backed by 1-to-1 coaching and a support group of others wanting to tackle their habits. And it's free and completely confidential. See https://harvestchurch.uk/fresh-start

Did you know that:

- 44% of people in the UK gamble. 27% do it in-person (lottery, bingo, bookies etc.), and another 27% gamble online.
- 2.7 million people are either 'at risk gambling' (experiencing moderate harm) or 'problem gambling' (serious harm).
- Many gamblers act secretively often online at night concealing it, even to their partners.
- On average, 6-10 other people are affected by a problem gambler's activities: typically friends and family.
- Gambling has the highest suicide rate of all addictions 409 suicides were attributed to gambling in the UK last year, and the real figure may be much higher.
